Prayer Requests

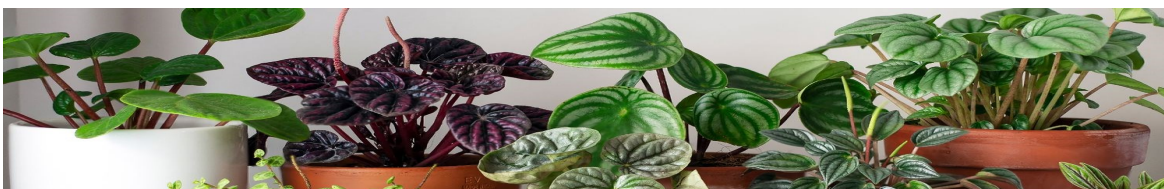
There are many who are traveling during the holiday season. Please pray for their safety.
